The following information is being provided in response to questions for this RFP:

1) Can the ATMs be bolted to the floor or wall?

a) Floor is preferred, but both can be accommodated.

- 2) Can you provide a historic breakdown of surcharged and non-surcharged ATM withdrawals per ATM or as a total? If the answer is no, is there any form of historical data you can provide?
  - a) See attachment A for the information available to ECTC.
- 3) What is the current surcharge at each ATM?
  - a) NA current machine is disconnected.
- 4) What is the commission split and/or rent paid by the current provider?
  - a) NA current machine is disconnected.
- 5) How much is the minimum rental payment?
  - a) NA current machine is disconnected.
- 6) Who is the current ATM provider?
  - a) Current machine is disconnected; however, in the past services have been provided by Abound Credit Union.
- 7) What is the monthly transaction volume for the previous 36 months?
  - a) See attachment A for the information available to ECTC.
- 8) What was the previous fee structure (convenience fees, transaction fees, etc.)?
  - a) No previous structure.
- 9) What was the previous revenue split?
  - a) There was no previous revenue split.
- 10) Are there any restrictions to the additional services we are able to conduct on the ATM, e.g., credit card cash advances; currency conversions; crypto currency sales and purchases?
  - a) ECTC is open to additional services in the proposals, but reserve the right to disallow any services that do not meet the needs of the institution and students.
- 11) Is the solicitor supportive of vendor establishing third party relationships to achieve low / no-cost consumer transaction fees?
  - a) ECTC is supportive only upon review and approval.
- 12) What are the specific equipment requirements for the ATM machines? Such as: Is there a specific brand or model of machine that you require? Also do you require multiple denominations or is one demonization sufficient?
  - a) ECTC does not require a specific brand or model of machine. ECTC requires the following denominations:
  - \$1; \$5; \$10; \$20; \$50; \$100

- 13) If applicable, what is the make and model of the current ATM equipment in use?
  - a) There is currently no equipment in use for ATM services at ECTC.
- 14) If applicable, how many terminals are currently deployed?
  - a) One. ECTC is open to multiple terminals at different locations on campus.
- 15) Can we bolt ATMs to the floor?
  - a) Yes.
- 16) Are armored services required? If so, will the cash loaders be able to enter the ATM locations within the airport with their sidearms?
  - a) ECTC is not an airport. Armored services are not required; however can be used at the choice of the awarded supplier.
- 17) Is there a security clearance level required to enter the airport ATM service areas?
  - a) ECTC is not an airport. No security clearance provided.
- 18) What type of bill denominations do you require to be dispensed to ATM customers?
  - a) ECTC requires the following: \$1; \$5; \$10; \$20; \$50; \$100 Coin change as well
